a seamless transition to a 2nd commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol (KP) with ambitious binding mitigation targets and with similar commitments from those developed countries who are not party to this commitment period of the KP

Contributing to the global effort

whereby all developing countries should submit nationally appropriate actions as part of their fair share of the global effort to address climate change, with the support of developed countries

Protect our vulnerable people and places

Protect the vulnerable

by taking measures to deal with existing and future impacts of climate change especially for the vulnerable, including compensation for loss and damage Doha must lay the basis for a fair, ambitious and binding agreement by 2015

Save our forests

by taking urgent action to stop the destruction and degradation of our forests and ensure that funds are available for this.

Developed countries should commit immediate funding to the Green Climate Fund from 2013 to support developing countries to reduce emissions and deal with the impacts of climate change

Meeting the \$100 bn commitment
